



Covid-19 Update 21st July 2020

The Minnis Bay Windsurfing Club's Covid-19 Committee are planning to relax some of the restrictions which have been forced upon us, in line with new government guidelines, as from Saturday 25th July 2020.

We still need to make sure we follow the guidelines of:

- *Maintaining social distancing of 2m, or 1m with mitigations where necessary.*
- *No group gatherings of more than six people from different households.*
- *Maintaining hygiene levels in any communal areas, or shared equipment.*

There are a few areas which we plan to help you enjoy the use of the Club's facilities, all of which relate to the hut and its vicinity.

Changing rooms

It is preferable if members continue to change in or beside their own vehicles if possible, but for those who cannot, there will be one changing room available for their use.

Please do not linger for longer than necessary in case others wish to use the facility.

Do not leave personal possessions within the changing room.

The changing room available is the one on the right, at the back of the hut.

Before entering the hut to use the changing room, always wash or sanitise your hands.



Catering

The kettle will now be available to use.

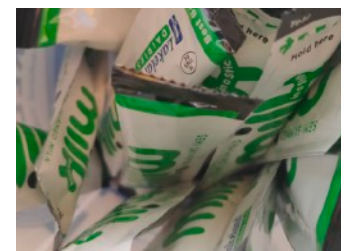
To reduce contact with products, sachets for coffee, tea, milk and sugar are now available. There are also small selection packs of biscuits.

If several people would like a brew, then one person should make and serve hot water to those who want it and they can add their own tea bag and milk as required, or make the drinks for all their own household.

To help reduce contact and improve hygiene, you may wish to bring and look after your own favourite mug. There are disposable recyclable cups in case you forget. Please put in the bin provided afterwards, or keep for yourself to use again, and again...

Only one person in the hut at a time, or one plus someone else in the changing room (unless from same household).

Before using the kettle or handling any serving items, always wash or sanitise your hands.



Furniture

For the time being, please continue to use your own chairs if you sit outside.

If very sunny, the parasols can be used, but please sanitise your hands before setting up or putting away.

Additionally, if windy, the windbreak can be used, but again, please sanitise your hands before setting up or putting away.

If sitting on the decking area, please ensure plenty of space is left for others to access to the hut if required.

If a larger household group wishes to sit together, then the rear decking can be used.



Remember

Any Club member not wishing to follow these rules is requested to remain away from the Minnis Bay Windsurfing Club's facilities during this period of pandemic.

It should be made clear that the Club will not be held responsible if any Club member catches Covid-19 and members must accept that there is always a risk wherever they go. These guidelines mitigate this as far as practically possible.

Failure to comply with the Club's regulations may result in immediate and indefinite expulsion from the Club and any car parking permit must be returned forthwith with no recompense.
